

Supplemental Appendix G. Examples of incorrect syntactic production by children with language impairment.

Target sentence	Child's utterance
Monkey said that dog pushed the pram.	Monkey said the pram push over.
Monkey wished that dog would cook sausages.	Monkey wished that he wants sausages for breakfast.
Horse hopes that monkey finds the doll.	Horse hope monkey can't find it. Horse hoped so monkey find the doll.
Horse thought monkey fixed the door.	Horse thought he fixed the oven but monkey fixed it.
Cat helped giraffe climb the ladder.	Cat helps giraffe hold his hand in the ladder. Cat helped giraffe push himself up the slide.
Monkey pretended that dog drank coffee.	Monkey pretend dog eat cup of tea he's drinking.
Giraffe wanted pig to hold his hand.	Giraffe wanted pig to help to hold his hand.
Dog wished horse would hold the ladder.	Dog wished horse wasn't holding the play.
Horse forgot monkey pushed the swing.	Horse forgot monkey pushed him again.
