The four versions of each stimulus type (example based on the vowel pair /I/-/i:/): original short, original long, lengthened, and shortened. Contrasts between the different versions of these stimulus types form the basis for the different conditions of a same-different task: (a) the original short vowel and the original long vowel for the spectro-temporal condition; (b) the original short vowel and the lengthened short vowel, or the original long vowel and the shortened long vowel, or the original long vowel and the lengthened short vowel, for the spectral condition.
