<b>Two key words</b>

<b>Three key words</b>
<u>Bears</u> <u>sleep</u> during <u>winter</u> .
<u>I</u> find it <u>difficult</u> to <u>lie</u> .
<u>What</u> would <u>you</u> like to <u>eat</u> ?
<b>Four key words</b>
I want a <u>little bit</u> of <u>meat</u> with <u>a lot</u> of <u>vegetables</u> .
<u>First</u> , <u>we</u> are going to <u>dance</u> at the <u>party</u> .
<u>I</u> have <u>drunk</u> <u>enough</u> <u>tea</u> .
