

Supplemental Material S1. Sample vocabulary instructional script.

Introduce the word	Wow, it’s raining so hard that now I am all wet! The amount of rain is excessive . Too much means excessive .
Direction to worksheet and verbal/moto-kinesthetic action	NARRATOR: Put your pencil on the clouds and trace the line to the cook and the dishes. If your pencil is on excessive , then say, “That’s way too much!”
Repetition of vocabulary word	Draw another dish on the stack and repeat the new word. Did you say excessive ? Way to go!
Definition and context	Excessive means too much. Look at the man with the dirty dishes. What a mess! There’s too much to wash! He has an excessive amount of work to do. Has your teacher ever told you there was too much noise in the classroom? Your teacher says, “Quiet down!” when the noise is excessive . Abbie the Ant thinks there is an excessive amount of rain today. There is just too much water falling from the sky!
Expressive naming task	ABBIE: Wow- there is too much rain today! Hey, do you remember the word that means too much? Excessive , that’s it! Remind me again what excessive means. Too much- you’re doing great!
End of lesson review	Another word for too much is.... Excessive . Now say “ <i>Too much!</i> ” Put your pencil on the cook and the dishes and color in the bubble. What does excessive mean? Too much- way to go!
